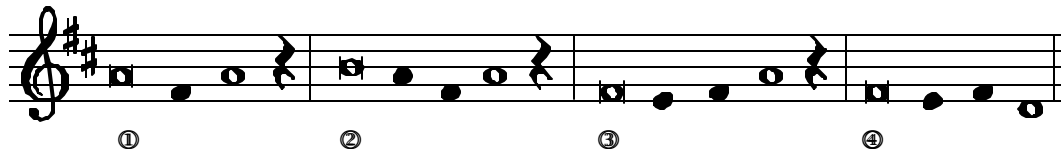


# Psalm 130
